1. Introduction to the workshop and need of data crowdsourcing in IIITA?

Speaker: Dr. Pawan Chakraborty **Brief:** The focus of the workshop is to raise awareness about the need of the generation of new data for the research and challenges of collecting the social data such as data for marketing analysis, trend analysis, speech analysis, EEG recordings for emotion etc.

2. What is the need of data collection? Why crowdsourcing is emerging as a new trend?

Speaker: Mr. Sudhakar Mishra **Brief:** Data collection is an important, often necessary, part of quality improvement. It becomes necessary when existing data are not sufficient for identifying or analyzing problems or for developing, testing, or implementing solutions to those problems. Crowd is diverse, so sampling across crowd provides wide spectrum of representative target audience. Result of analysis of such data, on average, would be applied to larger population.

3. How to Crowdsource and rewards to be associated?

Speaker: Mr. Abdul Momin **Brief:** Students are least motivated to support the research of their peers, the student requesting for data struggles for gathering small dataset even from the google form, leave apart the lengthy and tiring studies that goes for an hour or two. Thus, we must understand how the researcher should ask for crowdsourcing a dataset, how the responding students should contribute in the dataset, and how the rewards can be provided staying within the rules of the institute.
